Our Christmas Recital is just over a month away and our dancers are very excited to showcase their routines and get everyone in the holiday spirit! Tickets will go on sale **November 6th**. Additional details are below:

Christmas Recital date: Sunday, December 3

Where: Red Deer Memorial Centre (4214 58 St. Red Deer, beside Lindsay Thurber High School)

Time: 2 p.m. (estimated show length of 45 minutes - 1 hour) **Tickets:** \$18 (children 3 and under are free if sitting on a lap).

Seating is reserved, meaning you pick your seat numbers when you purchase your tickets. Dancers do NOT require a ticket.

Any remaining tickets can purchased at the door the day of the performance.



Please see the attached Costume, Hair and Make-Up checklist. A reminder that all Recreational and Rising Stars dancers will be wearing the same costume for the Christmas Recital that they will also be wearing for festival (Rising Stars only) and the year-end recital. Please refrain from wearing your costume during the season when you are not performing. We recommend hanging it in a safe place to avoid wrinkling and damage.

Because Junior, Intermediate and Senior costumes have longer shipping times and don't arrive before our Christmas Recital, we make every effort to put together costumes for this performance from items that dancers already own.

Before the show

Dancers should arrive 20 minutes prior to showtime with their hair and make-up done. You may enter the CAT doors, which are to the left of the Memorial Centre's main doors. Follow the hallway through to the backstage area. Theatre ushers will be available to provide directional assistance for anyone new to the Memorial Centre.

Once backstage you can find your assigned dressing room area to get dressed and store your dancer's belongings. Please remember to label all costumes, tights and shoes with your dancer's name in the event that something is misplaced!

Our Recreational and Rising Stars dancers will sit with their assistant teachers backstage before the show begins, but we would love to have some additional parent volunteers backstage for our Kinderdance and Mini Movers and Groovers classes. One volunteer is needed per class to sit with the dancers until they perform, as our assistants sometimes have to leave to perform their own routines. Once the group performs, you are welcome to return to your seat in the theatre.

If you would like to volunteer, please send us an email and we will mark you down! We will reimburse each volunteer the price of their ticket for the show as a token of our appreciation.

During the show

Once our Kinderdance and Mini Movers and Groovers perform, they are welcome to sit with their families to watch the remainder of the show. You can make your way to the backstage area after their performance to grab your little one. All dancers will be brought up on stage at the end of the recital for speeches and awards, and can come back onto the stage via the stairs at the front.

After the show

Our Christmas Recital is short and sweet! It should last roughly 45 minutes to one hour from start to finish. Once we are done, dancers may go! Please double check the dressing room before you leave to ensure you have all of your belongings!

Christmas break

The studio will be closed for Christmas break from December 22 - January 7. Classes will resume on Monday, January 8th. We hope everyone has a wonderful holiday season!
