Performing Arts costume & festival fees

Holiday Cheer Week Performing Arts Level 1-5 costumes have started to

arrive for festivals! We will be trying costumes on this month during classes.

The remaining balances for costumes and festival fees will be distributed in the New Year. Once payment is received in full and all other studio fees are up to date, dancers may take their costumes home.

A reminder that costumes should only be worn for performances to keep them in good condition. If alterations are needed, Amber's Alterations is a local option with lots of dance costume experience. Rising Stars dancers will wear the same costumes from the Christmas Recital for their festival and year-end performance.

Dancers are encouraged to wear holiday themed attire, clothing and pis the final week of classes, December 15-18. We look forward to spreading holiday cheer!



Lobby etiquette reminder

As we approach the second half of the season, a reminder to all dancers and dance families about studio lobby etiquette. A few things to keep in mind:

- No running, climbing or jumping off of studio furniture or props.
- No playing in storage closets.
- The front desk area is for staff only. Dancers and siblings should not be behind this area and all cupboards and supplies left alone.
- The basement is for washroom use and dancer changerooms only. We ask that younger siblings please do not run around downstairs, as dancers use this space to change.
- If parents are waiting with a sibling, please ensure your child has an activity to keep them quiet and entertained. Children running, banging on viewing windows, and yelling are disruptive to the classes in session.

Our studio is our second home, and we want to ensure a respectful and safe learning environment for everyone. Thank you from G2D!
